

BSA Health and Medical Forms

**TURN IN TWO COPIES OF THESE FORMS FOR OUR TROOP RECORDS
(One for the TRAVEL binder and one for the EMERGENCY BACKUP BINDER)**

It is important that you fill in ALL of the information.

Here are additional details for these forms.

Part A – Informed Consent, Release Agreement, and Authorization

Part B – General Information/Health History

also include front AND back of your medical insurance card

- Part A & Part B are completed by parents annually.
- Their completion is required before attending any campout.
- These are forms that you can fill out on your computer and save to your computer for easy updating each year.
- Section B1 requires you to include a photocopy of the front and back of your medical insurance card-- please be sure to include copies for Adult leaders and each of your children. Again we will need two copies for each person so that we can hold in both binders.

Part C – Pre-Participation Physical ONLY REQUIRED FOR OVER 72-HOUR EVENTS
(SUMMER CAMP)

- Most doctors will complete this form free of charge at your annual physical. If you need to get it filled out at another time of year they can fill it out if you have had an appointment less than a year ago, but most charge a small fee for this (\$10?) We get the BSA and student athlete forms filled out each year at annual exam so we don't have to pay any fees. Consider putting a reminder on your calendar.
- If you are unable to get through your regular physician due to timing, you can get it completed at pharmacy clinics or perhaps KidMed. I am unsure what type of fees they charge.

These three parts of the BSA form expire one year after the last day of the month in which they were signed. For example, if your forms were signed on June 1, 2022 (or any day in June 2022), they would expire June 30, 2023.
