

The Adult Leader Scouting Uniform

Once you have completed the Adult Leader Application, have gone through the background check and have completed Youth Protection Training, you can assist with application of the Scouts BSA program. Most of the male adult leaders in our troop wear the Scout BSA uniform.

What parts of the scout uniform do adults wear?

- Everything but the merit badge sash and the advancement patch on the front left pocket.

Uniforms can be purchased at the Scout Store located at 8090 Villa Park Drive, Richmond, VA. Store hours: Mon-Tues 9am-5:30pm, Wed Noon-6pm, Thur-Fri 9am-5:30pm and Saturday 9am-Noon.

Shopping for uniform items (Scout Store staff can help you):

1. Scout short sleeve shirt
2. World Crest Emblem (purple)
3. Council Shoulder Insignia
4. Web Belt - scout colored. Not required to be official.
5. Scout pants/shorts - scout colored pants or shorts are fine. Not required to be official.
6. Scout shoulder loops. (We purchase for Scouts, you purchase as an Adult Leader)

The following items will be provided to you by Troop 788:

1. Neckerchief & Woggle
2. Troop number patch.

“Class A” uniform consists of the scout shirt, scout pants/shorts, and scout belt. Class A is generally worn for weekly meetings.

“Full Class A” uniform includes Class A plus the neckerchief and woggle to be worn at Courts of Honor, Scout Sunday, Open Houses, and ceremonies.

“Class B” uniform consists of any Scouting-related shirt and scout pants/shorts. Class B is worn for summer weekly meetings.
