[Troop 788 Confirmation/Deposit Deadline: 2/15/26](#)

Please RSVP on Scoutbook! An email will be sent confirming the adult leader cost after we have a final count. All deposits are non-refundable. Please make your deposit \$200/Scout, and/or \$100/AL using Zelle to pay directly into our Troop 788 Bank Account. Our Outdoor Activities Coordinator will make one payment for the troop.

[Troop 788 Merit Badge Selection Deadline: 3/1/26](#)

Scouts select the merit badges they are most interested in completing at camp. Our Outdoor Activities Coordinator will do their best to register scouts for their preferences, but certain slots fill up fast. New Scouts are recommended to do the Raven Scouts program, first aid and swimming as this leads to good advancement and important early skills. [Troop 788 Final Payment Deadline: 4/15/26](#)

Your final payment for summer camp will be calculated by an adult leader after Merit Badge Registration has been completed. You will most likely receive an email detailing the amount you owe as well as when that final payment is due.

BSA Medical Form Deadline: 6/4/26

(2 Printed COPIES + 2 Printed COPIES front and back of your insurance card)

Use this form to type in your scout's information. You can then save it on your personal computer so that you can save on your personal computer and easily make adjustments when completing it the next year. The entire troop updates their forms A & B in June each year. Form C requires a physician signature – plan to get this form completed at your child's annual physical exam– most will sign without a charge if you have it done at a wellness visit. If you were not aware this was needed at your last appointment or forgot and you will not have another appointment before summer camp, most offices will complete the form for you for a small fee.

Instructions for filling out BSA Medical Forms

Please take the time to check and make sure you have completed, signed and dated all of the necessary parts of the forms. Including double checking that your child's physician has signed and dated their part of Form C. We will review forms as you submit them but ultimately, it is your responsibility as the parent to ensure everything is complete. Medical forms will be checked by camp staff upon arrival at summer camp.

Troop Medication Information Form Due: 6/4/26

(1 Printed COPY)

Required form for any scout bringing medication (prescription or over the counter) to summer camp.

RKSR-R Outdoor Programs Parental Release Due:

6/4/26 (1 Printed COPY)

Required for all scout participants. A parent/ guardian must sign/approve waivers for participants under the age of eighteen.

RKSR-D Special Diet/food needs/allergies Due: 5/21/26

(1 Printed COPY)

BEFORE MAY 21, 2026 - Complete this form which is required for all scout and adult leaders with special dietary needs or food allergies. We will consolidate into one form and email it to registration@ravenknob.com before JUNE 1, 2026.

GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY TIPS FOR CAMP

- Wear closed-toe shoes at all times.
- Bring water shoes (or shoes that can get wet) for aquatics activities.
- Use sunscreen and insect repellent daily. Check for and remove ticks daily.
- Carry a flashlight when walking at night.
- Shake out clothes and shoes before wearing them.
- Keep food and other smellable items out of tents.
- Shower daily.
- Drink plenty of water.
- Use the buddy system.
